Hi! Thanks for your interest in promoting character education, wellness, math, science, reading, and more through my high-energy, high-impact arts-in-education programs. Please see www.injest.com/arts-in-ed for current descriptions, study guides, references, etc.

While my fee for shows and keynotes in some venues is \$2400, below are discount fees for 2009-2010 arts-in-ed programs *including travel* in most cases.

Fee for one assembly program:

If flying within the continental U.S.....	\$1800
If driving 300 miles or more.....	\$1200
If driving less than:	
300 miles.....	\$900
250 miles.....	\$800
200 miles.....	\$700
150 miles.....	\$600
100 miles.....	\$500
50 miles.....	\$450

With any assembly program, you can also get:

Additional back-to-back programs.....	\$150
Juggling Playshops*.....	\$75
Evening program (Family Fun Night).....	\$350
Staff development program.....	\$350

*Combine performances and playshops for a 1-day to 5-day residency that teaches juggling and life skills.

Co-sponsor with others and save:

Program in another location on same day.....	\$350
Program in another location on consecutive day....	\$450

Distance from Buffalo, NY usually determines the regular fee. For example, a school in Cleveland, OH (200 miles from Buffalo) could have one program for only \$700; two schools in that area could have one program each for only \$1050 total (\$700 + \$350) or \$525 each.

If budget constraints are a problem, contact In Jest to find out when I'll be in your area or to discuss other possibilities. Note that an additional overnight fee may apply in some situations. Also, fees for programs booked through Young Audiences or other agencies may vary.
